



Access our new Connect Provider Portal by going to radiologyregional.com, For Providers > Provider Portal. Click on the RR Connect Provider Portal button to log in to your account.

Viewing Study

On the left side of the screen, you can view a list of all exams performed in patients chart.



Once an exam is selected, options (via tabs) appear


Visit summary: Summary of patient's visit

Report: View diagnostic report. Can save as PDF file or can print

Images: Allows you to view only that single image corresponding to the selected title in a PDF file

Downloading Study

For providers who want to download images into their PACs or EMR, please follow these instructions:



Select desired exam, click the **Images** tab, click the **Download** button

Select desired format under **"Choose file type"** field

How to Download Images

Process for Downloading Images
Downloading Images is a two-step process:

1. Select images to be processed:
 - o Select the file format for your images:
 - .ZIP is the typical format when saving images to a computer or an external hard drive.
 - .ISO is used if you intend to later burn the images to CD or DVD.
2. Download processed images to your device.
 - o Image processing can take several minutes. You will be notified when processing is complete.
 - o Once processed, images will only be available for a finite period.

"Need Help" link provides explanation of the different file formats (zip. and iso.), along with a disclaimer about the potential time required to download the images

You must acknowledge that you are downloading Protected Health Information (PHI) and understand the associated disclaimer by checking the box that states: **“Yes, I understand that I am downloading Protected Health Information (PHI)”**

Once acknowledged, you will be able to click **“Download”**

Preparing Images for Download

The system may take a few minutes to prepare the images to be downloaded. You can wait for the images to be ready for download or you can enter your email to be notified when the images are ready for download (you may exit/log out of portal and return when email is received). Email will contain a link that directs to portal login page, where you can access and download images.
